

## DR. SOLOMON DE SOLA

Dr. Solomon De Sola of 360 Central Park West, a dental surgeon here for fifty-six years, died Thursday in New York Hospital after a brief illness. His age was 83. His office was at 654 Madison Avenue.

Dr. De Sola was graduated from the University of Pennsylvania Dental School in 1900. He later attended the Sorbonne in Paris. Treasurer and a director of the First District Dental Society of New York for thirteen years, Dr. De Sola received a plaque in 1939 honoring his services. In 1950 the Dental Society of the State of New York made him a life member.

Surviving are a son, Ralph of San Diego, Calif.; a brother and two granddaughters.
