During the night and the next morning about two hundred students and a hundred and fifty other persons were arrested. The mob then tried to storm the prison, but the soldiers again charged, and began firing, whereupon the rioters dispersed. Proclamations were then issued forbidding the students to enter the University any more until further notice. Several personages of high position are among the wounded, including the Procurator of the Sacred Synod, M. Pobedonosheff. This unfortunate outbreak has, of course, completely upset the festival in celebration of the Academical Jubilee.
