JEWISH SETTLERS AND JEWISH OWNERS OF PROPERTY IN DUTCH-BRAZIL 1634-1654

This list of those I collected names of Jewish settlers and Jewish owners of property in Dutch Brazil is a framework for further research into the history of the Jewish settlers and Jewish owners with property in Dutch Brazil, their backgrounds, their family ties and their Dutch possessions in Brazil.

Further study of the claimed damages by the Jewish settlers and merchants In the National Archives in The Hague will give more insight about the possessions of the applicants in Dutch Brazil.

Most data on the Jewish settlers in Dutch Brazil I took from the book "The Dutch in Brazil 1624-1654" written by the Brazilian JA Gonsalves de Melo

The Brazilian writer / historian JAGonsalves de Mello learned the 17th century Dutch in the Netherlands, the documents themselves to Dutch Brazil and WIC to study in the National Archives in The Hague and later the data to be translated into Portuguese. The book was translated into Dutch by Dr. Garmant Nico Visser, specialist in Latin American Human Geography. In 1997 the Dutch translation of the manuscript presented to the Brazilian Embassy in The Hague. This left the issue in 2001.

4th List v / d "THE BRAZILIAN PRETENSIEEN" 4th List in 1663 v / d

With the names of 82 Portuguese Sephardic Jewish Settlers from Dutch Brazil, who could

apply for compensation for their lost goods in Dutch Brazil after their departure in 1654. In January 1634 by proclamation of the States General of Holland announced that there was religious freedom for all inhabitants in Dutch Brazil. Many of the Dutch in Brazil living Crypto Jews (those who are Roman Catholic, had been forcibly baptized) new Christians / called conversos or Marranos, turned back to their old Jewish faith and traditions.

In 1635 allowed themselves the following Crypto Jewish merchants from Dutch Brazil are circumcised according to the law of Moses and became members of the Jewish community: VASCO FERNANDES and his sons Balthasar de FONSECA alias SAMUEL BELHIOS and his sons Miguel RODRIGUES MENDES MIGUEL and his sons FRANCISCO GASPAR DA COSTA FERNANDES DA VALE Simao DA VALE

The Jewish settlers of Dutch Brazil consisted of 3 groups:

CRYPTO JEWS who first from Portugal and Spain as colonists had gone to Brazil.

Second Sephardic Jews first for the Inquisition in 1600 from Portugal and Spain had fled to Holland and after 1630 as Jewish settlers and from Amsterdam to Brazil.

Third ASJKENASISCHE JEWS 30 Years War 1618-1648 from Germany and Poland had fled to Holland and after 1630 as Jewish settlers departed from Amsterdam to Brazil

In 1635 came the first large group of Jewish settlers to Dutch Brazil conducted MOISES COHEN HENRIGUES alias JAN (JOHN) HARRISON) it asks permission on 02/09/1634 at WIC (West India Company) with Jewish settlers from Amsterdam to settle in Dutch Brazil

The Jewish settlers arrived in Recife and settled on the offshore island "Itamaracá" (47 km. north of Recife)

In 1636 there is mention of a synagogue with Rabbi Jacob Itamaraca LAGARTO.

In 1636 there is mention of a synagogue in Paraiba situated in a center of sugar plantations.

In 1636 there is mention of a synagogue in OLINDA located in a center of sugar plantations.

In 1636 in Recife were the services of the Jewish community held in a house to house, 2 Synagogue wealthy Jewish sugar merchants in Recife.

In the first house of David Senior Coronel aka DUARTE SAVAIRA in Jodenstraat to Recife. In the second house of Giacomo PAULO PINTO PINTO aka Jacob Jessurun in the street of the Jews in Recife.

In 1636 the first synagogue built in Recife it was named "Kahal ZUR ISRAEL" (Rock of Israel) Jews in the street (Rua do Bom Jesus) in Recife. (On August 12, 1636 will be reported to the Zeeland chamber v / d WIC in Middelburg that the Jews are working to build their synagogue).

First rabbi (unknown) 2e in 1641 Rabbi First Rabbi Isaac Aboab da Fonseca (unknown) On 11.17.1636 asks Nehemiah aka MANUEL MENDES DE CASTRO

1st SAMUEL ISRAEL second rabbi Rabbi RAPHAEL DE AGUILAR MOISES
On 11.16.1648 the merger takes place between 2 synagogues.
In 1645 Jewish settlers tried many times again Dutch Brazil after the uprising against the
Dutch by the Portuguese.
Between 1648 and 1653 there were 171 Jewish male members over 13 years. These
names are listed in the minute book of the two Jewish communities (the total
congregation consisted of about 720 persons).
The minute book has survived and was taken to Amsterdam in 1654.
The names listed in the minute book are displayed in Portuguese.
The Jewish citizens Often use 2 names and the names were written in Various ways
DAVID DUARTE Senior Coronel aka SARAIVA a Jewish name and a BUSINESS NAME that
was used in doing business etc.

At the city OLINDA was the largest concentration of the cane the city were on the coast
26 km north of Recife.
The city was Founded in 1534 by the Portuguese in 1631 and Occupied by Waerdenburgh
or All which the city is largely shot on fire.
Because the city was poor defending was the trading center for sugar storage and moved
to Recife, where a natural port.
The WIC traveled a path of pavers to Olinda to Recife to the heavy shipments of sugar to
Work Properly.
In Recife, large sugar warehouses built and run the many ships are coming and going.
The chartering of the sugar was controlled by Jewish Mainly Both agents who speak
Portuguese and Dutch.

On 7/5/1637, a petition to Governor Johan Maurits of Nassau with the request to open up trade for the Jewish merchants. This was signed by Portuguese and Jewish merchants from Dutch Brazil.

In 1641 a petition was Presented to the Governor Johan Maurits of Nassau in Mauritsstad Behalf of some Dutch merchants from Recife to the Jewish merchants Expelled from Dutch Brazil and to confiscate Their goods.

Because Sephardic Jews in Dutch Brazil mastered the two languages, Portuguese and Dutch, and were associated with Significantly Their family in Amsterdam, They Were Able to coop with the Dutch rate in trade and finance the cultivation of sugar and ship freighting in Dutch Brazil.

Where the Sephardic Jews Easily adapted to the climate in Brazil, the Dutch had great difficulty getting there.

This raised a number of years after much jealousy that anti-Jewish mood arose. This was mainly directed against the rich Jewish merchants such as:

On January 26, 1654 Brazil is Dutch/colony v/d WIC back in the hands or de Portugezen.

In February 1654 did the Portuguese know That the Dutch and Jewish settlers (as Dutch citizens) 3 months had to depart with Their goods from Recife. Starting in May 1654 left 20 ships with about 3,000 refugees on board (Dutch and Jewish settlers) from the port of Recife to Holland.

In August 1654 the ships arrived from Recife to Amsterdam, where the Jewish settlers were captured Temporarily.

The Portuguese Jews from Recife difficult but could thrive in Amsterdam because of the conservative attitude of the Portuguese Israeli Municipality of Amsterdam. (Chaim Potok writes in his book "Wanderings")

Between 1655 and 1660 Turned many of the Jewish settlers through the WIC and with permission from England back as settler and firing Their knowledge of the cultivation and trade in sugar, tobacco, indigo and cocoa along to the West Indian islands and the colonies on the north coast of South America and North America.

The first islands of the West Indies, Including BARBADOS, CURACAO, JAMAICA, MARTINIQUE, QUAD LOUPE and TOBAGO

2nd Wild Coast Guyana on the northern coast of South America including Guyana CAYENNE, SURINAME, Berbice, ESSEQUIBO, DEMARARA and Pomeroun
And she put the Atlantic trade in sugar between Between WILLEMSTAD, BRIDGETOWN, NEW AMSTERDAM, LONDON and AMSTERDAM.

A third group of Portuguese Jewish families from Dutch Brazil settled in Amsterdam, Middelburg and LONDON.
